6. Which Canadian born female singer-songwriter was born Roberta Joan Anderson in 1943, wrote the songs 'Both Sides Now', 'Woodstock' and 'Big Yellow Taxi' which includes the line *"They paved paradise and put up a parking lot?"*
7. What do the 11 points on the Canadian maple leaf on its flag signify?
8. On what day of the year is Canada Day celebrated?
9. What book, has Anne Shirley as its main character, is set in Avonlea on Prince Edward Island, was written by Lucy Maud Montgomery and first published in 1908 and has since gone on to sell over 50 million copies worldwide?
10. What did the British call Canada until 1867?
