Logging In and Out – Passwords

Why Log In?

You can search very successfully in the ELIS catalogue without logging in. However if you want to make the fullest use of the catalogue you must log in.

How do I Log In?

You need your **ID number** which has been sent to enrolled exporters of the Diploma of International Trade, and your **password.** You should not lend these to anybody else or write them down in an obvious place.

What can I do?

A. These are the options you get immediately after you have logged in:

- You are able to see what you have out My Summary
- You are able to see if you owe the Library for lost books under **My Fines** (remember there are no fines for late returns)
- You can check your Personal details and change these if no longer correct My Personal Details
- You can change your Password Change My Password
- You can check the details of the last 50 titles you have borrowed My Reading History

B. When you do a search you can

- Place a Hold this means that we send the requested item to you, and
- You can Make a Purchase Suggestion
