

Online resources

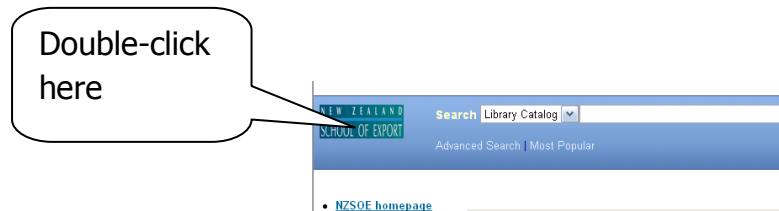

The term **Online resources** covers a range of resources – a website, a pdf document, or an electronic version of a print title. What they all have in common is that this resource is available on the internet. We have added this information because we want to ensure that you will be able to access this material yourself and get the information you need. Because the URLs are hotlinked you can click from the ELIS catalogue and will be able to get direct access to that online resource.
