**4,436,000 (as of 1<sup>st</sup> January 2010) Georgia is in 121<sup>st</sup> place which is two places above New Zealand (123<sup>rd</sup>), with Croatia in between at (122<sup>nd</sup>).**
2. What is the name of the capital city? **Tbilisi**
3. Name the four countries which border Georgia (one point for each).  
**Azerbaijan. Armenia. Russia. Turkey.**
4. On which expanse of water does Georgia have a sea-side? **Black Sea**
5. Who is the most famous Georgian who was born in Gori in 1879, expelled from the Tiflis Orthodox Theological Seminary in 1899, and died in 1953? **Stalin**
6. What is the main language spoken in Georgia? **Georgian**
7. Georgia (the country) shares its name with a U.S. state. What is the capital of the U.S. state? **Atlanta which hosted the Summer Olympic Games in 1996.**
8. In what year did Georgia become independent from the USSR? **1991**
9. What is the name of the two ethnic regions which are seeking independence from Georgia? (One point for each). **Abkhazia and South Ossetia.**
10. Which Apostle and Saint brought Christianity to Georgia? **Andrew**
